You didn't take the lids off your bottles. Come on mate! Go back 1 space.

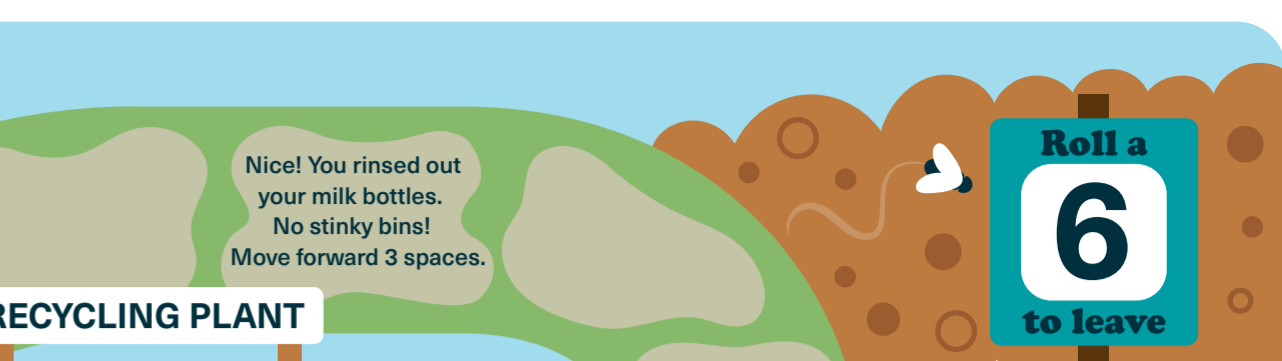
You correctly sorted your recycling, move forward 1 space.
